

TRI Supports AIDS Walk Washington

Washington, D.C. (Saturday, October 27, 2012): TRI raises awareness and funding for the Whitman Walker Health full-service community health center through participation in the annual AIDS Walk Washington that kicks off at Freedom Plaza in Washington, D.C.

The AIDS Walk in Washington, D.C., is a 5k walk/run fundraiser that benefits the Whitman-Walker Clinic, a non-profit community-based health organization that provides high-quality, comprehensive, and accessible health care to those who are infected or affected by HIV/AIDS. In Washington, D.C. alone, three percent of adults have HIV and an additional three percent are infected but do not know it. The AIDS Walk not only raises awareness and funding, but it also helps to prevent new infections. The AIDS Walk funds support for free legal services, public benefits, counseling, medical visits, medication, mentoring, and mental health therapy, among many other services.

This is TRI's fourth year participating in the walk. Each year TRI employees are encouraged to join in the event and TRI covers the registration fee/donation for each staff member who participates. TRI employees enjoy the opportunity to support the community and to take part in healthy activity.
