

TRI Supports AIDS Walk Washington for the Fifth Year

Washington, D.C. (Saturday, October 26, 2013): TRI raises awareness and funding for Whitman-Walker Health, a non-profit community-based health organization, through participating in the annual AIDS Walk Washington at Freedom Plaza in Washington, D.C.

The AIDS Walk Washington is a 5k walk/run fundraiser that benefits Whitman-Walker Health, to support the organization's mission to provide high-quality, comprehensive, and accessible health care to those who are affected by or infected with HIV/AIDS. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention estimate that more than one million Americans are living with HIV, and up to one-third of them do not know they are HIV-positive. In Washington, D.C. alone, the estimate is that one in every 20 adults is infected with HIV. The AIDS Walk Washington funds support for free legal services, public benefits, counseling, medical visits, medication, mentoring, and mental health therapy, among other services.

Each year TRI employees are encouraged to join in the event to enjoy the opportunity to support the community and take part in healthy activity. TRI covers the registration fee/donation for each employee who participates.
